For each subject are 150 except in the case of Science without practical (subject code—90 & 91) for which are 105.

A student must obtain atleast Grade E in SUPW and 33% marks or Grade E in five out of the remaining six subjects.

Candidates who are exempted from one or both the subjects of Internal Examination should in order to pass the examination, obtain atleast 35% marks in at least four subjects of External Examination.

In the subjects of Internal Examination are based on internal assessment by the school. Range of marks in each grade are: A 75% and above, B 60% to 74%, C 53% to 59%, D 45% to 52%, E 38% to 44%, F 15% to 37%, G 14% or less.

Candidate failing in two subjects will be placed in compartment. Candidates placed in compartment may re-appear in either of the two subjects to clear the same in the next compartmental examination. Only two chances, in the following July and March next, are given to clear the subject of compartment.

- F. alongwith the marks of a subject indicates Fail.
- AB, under the code No. of a subject indicates Absent.
- EX, under the code No. of a subject indicates Exempted.
- W, Subjects of Internal Examination.

Optional language / subject. 'P' against it indicates Pass in it. 'N' against it indicates Not taken into account for passing the examination and in the total marks.
