ORDER

They will be on probation for a period of 2 (two) years with effect from the date of joining in their respective place of posting as shown above.

The terms and conditions of appointment will be as follows:-

- (1) The services will be governed by CCS (Temporary Services Rules) 1965 as amended from time to time.
- (2) The appointment carries with it the liability to serve any part of Arunachal Pradesh or outside the State where Arunachal Government has an organization as may be decided by Govt. from time to time in the interest of public service.
- (3) The appointment will be governed by relevant rules and orders of Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh issued from time to time.
- (4) The candidate should not have more than one wife at the time of appointment and throughout his service.
