The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to appoint Dr. Tai Riso, an Arunachal Pradesh Government nominee to the post of Medical Officer on ad-hoc basis with effect from his joining the post in the scale of pay of Rs. 2200-75-2800-EB-100-4000/- p.m. plus NPA and other allowances as admissible under rules in force from time to time in Arunachal Pradesh.

As per terms and condition of the bond executed by Dr. Tai Riso, at the time of his admission to the MBBS course, Dr. Tai Riso, will have to serve in Arunachal Pradesh for a minimum period of 3 years.

Other terms and conditions of services which are not specified herein will be governed by the relevant rules and orders in force in Arunachal Pradesh.

In the interest of Public Service Dr. Tai Riso, Medical Officer is posted to District Hospital, Khonsa.

Further, Dr. Tai Riso, Medical Officer will have to appear before the selection Board of Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission for the purpose of regularisation of his ad-hoc appointment as and when he is called for. His ad-hoc appoint will not confer any right to claim seniority over others till regularisation of his ad-hoc service.
