OFFER OF APPOINTMENT



On the basis of the result of written test and also having been declared medically fit by the competent medical authority, the undersigned, as empowered under Delhi Police (Appointment & Recruitment) Rules, 1980, hereby given offer of appointment to Mrs. SUM PANGGOMLA Roll No. 250461
D/o PRITAM PANGGOMLA is hereby appointed as purely temporary Constable (Exe.) in Delhi Police in the pay scale of PB-1 Rs.5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs.2000 and other allowances as admissible to the Central Govt. employees in an existing vacancy. She shall be posted/allocated directly to PTC, Jharoda Kalan, New Delhi for basic training.

Her appointment is made under the Delhi Police Act, 1978 and will be governed under the Rules made there under. She will also be governed by the Central Civil Service (Temporary Services) Rules-1965 and CCS (Conduct) Rules-1964.

Her appointment is also subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The offer of appointment is to be valid on execution of an agreement bond with regard to refund of salary cost of uniform, capitation charges etc. in case she leaves the department without completing 5 years of service if confirmed, from the date of her appointment.
2. Her appointment is subject to the caste/tribe certificate being verified through proper channels and if the verification reveals that the claim of belonging to SC/ST/OBC, as the case may be, is false, the services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reason thereof and without prejudice to such further action as may be taken under the provision of law for production of false certificate.
3. Her appointment will be liable for termination if the facts given by her in the Declaration Form/Undertaking are found to be incorrect in any material aspect and she will be further liable to refund the money spent on his training or given to her from the State Exchequer. She shall also be debarred from Govt. Services in future, besides intimation of legal action against her.
4. She will be on probation for a period of two years from the date of her appointment.
5. Her appointment is purely temporary and liable for termination without assigning any reasons thereof.
6. Her basic training is for nine months or as may be decided by the Commissioner of Police, Delhi.
7. No trainee shall be accepted/allowed for training at PTS after 10 days of commencement of training exceptional circumstances and that too with the prior approval of the Commissioner of Police, Delhi.
8. She shall not be passed into the rank/sent to the District/Unit to which she is allocated for drawl of pay unless she has successfully completed the training and has "passed-out" of the PTS.
9. She is required to qualify in the final examination conducted at the end of the training course. A chance may be given to her, if she fails her services will be terminated under Rule-5 of the CCS (Temporary Services) Rules-1965.

10. In case a recruit is medically unfit to continue training she should proceed on medical leave with or without pay (as per her entitlement) and should re-commence the training with the next batch.
11. If she fails to attend 90% of the classes during initial training, will be debitted from taking the final examination. She shall be considered for termination of service if ordered to further undergo training with the next batch.
12. The order re-assignment of the trainees shall be based on the guideline being done by stating the marks obtained in the entrance examination and the marks obtained in the training at the Police Training School.
13. The women trainee will not incorporate themselves on account of pregnancy during the training. Women trainees who are pregnant will not be allowed to join training.
14. The Principal/PTC shall be the competent authority for initiating and finalizing if the recruit is still in the PTC disciplinary action against the recruit constables etc. shall also be the competent authority to pass order regarding termination of the services of a recruit constable in order to terminate an unsuitable trainee from the force at the stage of her training. Any one of the following grounds will be sufficient:

- 1. Frequent absence of the trainee from Child-Indoor Programme leading to a suspicion that she is an undevoted trainee and a habitual absentee and is not likely to become a good police officer.
- 2. Submission of false Medical Certificate from any Doctor for availing leaves or night duty rest.
- 3. Gross disrespect with the Indoor/Outdoor Instructions or with other trainees staff.
- 4. If she commits any mischief or any crime involving moral turpitude during training.
- 5. If any information submitted by the trainee is found to be false, fabricated or manipulated to gain employment.
- 6. Any other ground which adversely reflects her behaviour and if the trainee is otherwise found unsuitable for police service.

The basic training course for the post commences w.e.f. 04.04.2016 at Police Training School, Dwarka, New Delhi. She should report to Principal/PTS, Dwarka, New Delhi on or before 13.04.2016. She will not be allowed to join after elapse of 10 days from the commencement of training. In case she fails to report at PTS/Dwarka, New Delhi within the stipulated period, this offer of appointment and candidature for the post will stand cancelled.
